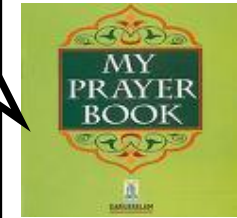

Do you know how Henry VIII changed the church?

We will be learning about Christianity, worship and the church.



We will have **cheer dancing** on **Thursday** afternoons and **P.E.** on Tuesdays. **Please remember your P.E. kits.**

We will be reading 'Rogues' Gold' – one of the Elizabethan mysteries. It is set in the Tudor times and is a spellbinding read. **Please bring your reading folders to school everyday.**

We will be learning about Henry VIII and his six wives. We will find out about Tudor clothes, food and their ways of life. We will be learning about dying using Tudor methods so please bring in an old white Tee shirt if you have one.

In science we will be learning about **Solids, Liquids and Gases**; how to make **solutions**; separate **mixtures**; and learn about **reversible** and **irreversible** changes.

We will be looking at the work of Archimboldo. He painted faces made up of fruit and vegetables.

In music we will be learning how to play the keyboards.
